- 6. Robyn and Chase married after she learned she was pregnant with Abby, and Robyn always believed Chase would not have married her otherwise. What do you think? Why do you think this?
- 7. After Robyn was abducted and beaten, she suffered post traumatic stress and did not contact her husband. Why do you think she didn't contact Chase?
- 8. Livy always protected Robyn. Do you think it's a good idea to always come to someone's defense? Why or Why not?
- 9. Alex lives in Texas and has roots that go all the way back to the Alamo. Livy in Mississippi. How do you see this relationship working out?
- 10. Do you believe Robyn and Chase will get back together? Why or why not?
